The Mesulam Center for Cognitive Neurology and Alzheimer's Disease at Northwestern University Feinberg School of Medicine offers a 2-year postdoctoral fellowship in research on neurodegenerative diseases under the triple mentorship of Changiz Geula, PhD, Tamar Gefen, PhD, and Marsel Mesulam, MD. Academic offices are located on Northwestern University's Chicago campus.

The investigations will focus on a large autopsy cohort linked to longitudinal imaging and neuropsychological data. Research topics will bridge disease pathophysiology to neuroanatomy and behavior. They will entail a seamless integration of neuroanatomy, neuropathology, Imaging and Neuropsychology. The brain bank is particularly strong in atypical Alzheimer's Disease and Frontotemporal Degenerations affecting language and behavior.

Academic activities include regular didactics in cognitive neurology and clinical neuropsychology, courses in neuroanatomy, CME-approved 'Roundtable' discussions, monthly Clinicopathologic Conferences, Departments of Psychiatry and Neurology Grand Rounds. Fellows also have opportunities for teaching and supervision of doctoral-level students.
